

Dear Ms. Vosburgh and Mr. Szende,

I am writing you today as Chair of the Council on Student Services, with regards to the Council's annual vote on Operating Plans and Compulsory, Non-Academic, Student Ancillary Fees. On March 4th, following a previously cancelled meeting, our Council met and attempted to reach a wider resolution on these outstanding tasks. However, our meeting did not receive the appropriate quorum to be able to do so in full.

Knowing then the deadlines we run up against in terms of the governance cycle, I write to you to ask if the Council could be given one further week to attempt to meet and resolve our outstanding duties. While we recognize the importance of informing University Affairs Board members of these processes in general and wish to not impede wider systems of governance, we also continue to see the value in having the student-voice (as encapsulated in the COSS process) put forward to UAB members.

In the Council's history since 1997, we have not had a situation of this type arise—where the Council's activities have not been able to be expressed in full—and it is the agreement of all members that have spoken to this point, that it would be a poor precedent for ourselves and for the University to set. That being said, we continue to recognize and understand in full the primacy of the UAB on matters such as this, but hope that such an extension can be given for the Council, at this time. We would expect nothing more of you than to consider the provision of such an extension up to the date of the provision of Board documents to the wider public.

In good faith, the Council has attempted to fulfill its duties and, as Chair, I have enjoined members—particularly those of the University of Toronto Students' Union—to finalize their processes as needed so that we would be able to move forward in an extended time frame. In the spirit of continued engagement with students in these important processes, I strongly hope that an allowance for a further meeting can be given at this time.

Finally, on a more operational note, I will be forwarding all Operating Plans and related documentation of the divisions impacted by the COSS process onward to your Acting Secretary, so as to ensure such documentation can be presented to members of the Board in the most prompt fashion possible.
